

Atlanta Specialty Plant Provides Boxes for Peace on the Move

This past year, PCA's specialty plant in Atlanta contributed to a local non-profit organization, Peace on the Move, by supplying boxes for their mobile food pantry. The pantry provides food to low-income families in the DeKalb County, Georgia, area.

As part of the plant's community outreach initiative, 30 PCA employees gathered to distribute over 1,500 tote boxes at a one-day volunteer event.

In addition to their mobile food pantry, Peace on the Move offers several programs — such as a recovery work program, a foster parent training program and a men's transitional home — to aid those in need.
