## PCA Chicago Donates Materials to Local Regatta

PCA's full-line plant in Chicago recently donated sheets of corrugated board to the park district of a nearby suburb, Glen Ellyn, for use in their annual Lake Ellyn Cardboard Boat Regatta. The event is held on the Saturday before the Fourth of July and is open to the public.

Participants must use only the number of corrugated sheets provided to them, and high-tech glue is not allowed. Last year, 35 handmade corrugated boats raced around the course on Lake Ellyn. "Brach the Brachiosaurus" was a fan favorite and winner of the Lake Ellyn Queen Award.
